Application Instructions

Austin College encourages high school foreign language teachers in Texas to apply for its Richardson Institute for Language Teachers, which will take place July 22-27, 2007. The purpose of the Institute is to develop and promote language fluency, cultural competence and computer technology skills through a week-long immersion program. Teachers need not have spent an extended period of time in a country that uses the target language, nor do they need extensive experience with using computers in the classroom. We seek highly motivated teachers with a variety of experience and skills. Dedication to teaching and a desire to explore new teaching methods and materials are essential.

The APPLICATION for the Institute consists of four items: a teacher application (attached), a principal's statement (attached), a one-page personal statement, and a résumé. Please send all materials in one envelope. Materials must be postmarked by **April 2, 2007**. Notification of acceptance will be made on or before **April 16, 2007**.
